ADOPT THE REGULATION OF PAROLE BOARD

By the powers and faculties conferred by Act No. 118 of July 22, 1974, as amended, known as the "Parole Board Act"; and Act No. 38 of June 30, 2017, as amended, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico", the Parole Board hereby announces its intention to adopt the "Parole Board Regulations". The proposed regulation has the purpose of establishing the norms that will govern the Parole Board in the Government Puerto Rico. The proposed regulation has the purpose of implementing the amendments to the Organic Law of the Parole Board, contained in Act No. 50-2026.

For this reason, the public is invited to submit their proposed amendments, comments or recommendations, or request an oral hearing, within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this notice.
